

Munich Itinerary

January 4

9 a.m. Arrive Munich

10 a.m. Board S-1 or S-8 line from underneath terminal. (Train leaves every 10 minutes)
(S-1 has a section that splits off and goes to Freising, so sit in right spot)

11 a.m. Hotel Check In

2 p.m. Afternoon visit to **Residenz** (45)

- Coffee at Munich's oldest café, the **Tambosi** or **Kafers** on **Odeonsplatz**

Evening

5 p.m. **Alte Pinakothek** (33)

7 p.m. Dinner at **Hofbräuhaus**

January 5

8 a.m. Breakfast

9 a.m. City tourist office, **Hauptbahnhof**. Get map.

- Cross **Bahnhofplatz**, square in front of station, go toward **Schutzenstrasse**.
- See **Hertie** department store.
- **Burgersaal** church, then **Michaelskirche** (36)
- **Augustiner Bierhalle**, brewery inn. (opposite Deutsches Jagd- und...)
- **Frauenkirche**, main cathedral w/ twin domes (39)
- From there head east to **Marienplatz/Neues Rathaus**.

12 p.m. **Altes Rathaus** (Old City Hall) (42)

- From Altes cross street, passing **Heiliggeistkirche** (church) and get into **Viktualienmarkt** (Food market for lunch) (43)
- From market follow **Rosental**, turn left onto **Sendlingerstrasse** (shopping street)
- Back to **Altes Rathaus**.
- Step into **Burgstrasse** and get in **Alter Hod**, the inner courtyard of the original palace.

Dinner anywhere

- After dinner drinks **Café Glockenspiel** on Marienplatz

Any Extra Time

- **Maximilianstrasse**, one of Europe's great shopping streets.
- **Kultfabrik**, Grafingerstrasse 6 (tel. **089/49 00 90 70**), offering more than two dozen concert venues, themed bars, and dance clubs.
